MODALITIES

Each participant must commit to actively participate to a minimum of two meetings per month, and expects to dedicate at least two hours per week (in average) to prepare the content of the meetings and of the blogs.

The IHF Secretariat will facilitate the exchanges by providing online tools enabling virtual meetings. Even though the Secretariat will generate the overall timeline, the group will have to self-manage the organization of their meetings and workplan through the creation of a steering committee.

The Steering Committee

At least 2 people per subgroup will be part of a steering committee. Within their working group, the members of the steering committee will supervise the organization of group meetings and of their blogs publication. The members of the steering committees will also meet outside of their working group meetings for overall coordination.

NOTICE TO THE EMPLOYER – REGARDING THE YEL'S PARTICIPATION TO THE IHF WHC

After meeting face-to-face during a one-day workshop, YELs will host a session in front of senior healthcare leaders to present their experience and results. This is considered as an important continuous professional development step, and employers should recognize this by allowing the YELs to participate to the Congress as part of their professional training.

The IHF will offer complementary registration to the IHF World Hospital Congress. It is expected that the travel expenses for the YEL's participation to the Congress will be covered by the applicant's employer. The applicant will be responsible for his/her own accommodation and for any required visa applications.

This year's WHC's overarching theme is "People on board, transforming healthcare. Blending agility, responsiveness, resilience", including three sub-themes:

- I. Digital and technology driven transformations;
- Towards an integrated concept of health and care services model: value driven transformation;
- III. People at the centre of healthcare system transformations.

The selected topics are a vehicle rather than an objective *per se*. Through this program, IHF seeks to connect young leaders across the world, broadcast the younger generation's perspectives on global challenges, and build sustainable relationships.

The program is divided into four phases:

- I. Online group meetings dedicated to relationshipbuilding and networking
- II. Selection of the working topics and division into subgroups
- III. Online meetings, chatting, and posting on the YEL Blog
- IV. At the WHC: one-day workshop with the other YELs; host a session; join the YEL Alumni
